Look at the picture of the earth shown below. The lines that go north and south are lines of longitude. Remember these facts about longitude:

- · Lines of longitude run north and south on the earth.
- The prime meridian is the line where we start to measure longitude. This line runs through Greenwich, England.
- · Longitude is measured east or west of the prime meridian.
- \circ The prime meridian is at 0°. West longitude extends from 0° to 180°. East longitude extends from 0° to 180°.

We use longitude to tell us how far east and west we are from the prime meridian. The numbers we use are called degrees of longitude.
